This application invites full-time students in their final year of an accredited Further or Higher Education course in fashion, textiles or weave related discipline, to apply for a maximum of 10 metres of double width Harris Tweed cloth.

Harris Tweed is the only fabric in the world governed by its own Act of Parliament, which decrees that genuine Harris Tweed must be made from pure virgin wool which has been dyed and spun on the islands and handwoven at the home of the weaver in the Outer Hebrides of Scotland.

Harris Tweed is renowned for its quality and longevity, and people around the world are captivated by the history and heritage that it carries. It is the fabric of choice for many of the world's leading designers and the Harris Tweed Authority Educational Trust is delighted to open up this opportunity to ten design students, so that they can too work with our world famous cloth.

The ten successful applicants will be able to choose up to a maximum of 10m (£400-500 worth) double width (150cm) Harris Tweed from a variety of different patterns selected by the Harris Tweed Authority. Choices will be set on a first come, first serve basis. (Terms and conditions apply. Please see page 4.)

- HTA reserves the right to share all photographs featuring the donated cloth for all Harris Tweed promotional purposes (for example, social media or press).
- Successful applicants will have the opportunity to choose 10m of Harris Tweed fabric from the Fabric Bank selection. Pattern and colour options are subject to availability.
- All details submitted are correct to the best of your knowledge, including the amount of Harris Tweed cloth requested for your design project.
